Introduction



- Digital drive
 - Most R&E institutions in Africa are now digitally driven
 - Resources are either moving or already online
- There is a need for specific services to:
 - Support collaborative research activities
 - Provide resource access beyond and outside the institution
- Federated Identity Management at the core of the above activities











Development of R&E Services



- Service outreach to science communities, deployment of R&E applications and access to repositories
- Trust and Identity for seamless access
- Proactive Cybersecurity for NRENs and their Digital Assets
- Federated Identity Management for Libraries











But... FIM Challenges in Africa

Africa 3, Connect 3,

- Different levels of maturity
- Inadequate capacity & expertise
- Limited government support
- Insufficient researcher engagement













Concepts



- Federation (eduID.africa)
 - Organization of IdPs and SPs with a common set of rules and standards
- IdP (Identity Provider)
 - Store and verify a user's digital identity
- SP (Service Provider)
 - Service that supports federated access





eduID.africa: Goals



- Facilitate and simplify introduction of shared services across the federation
- Fastrack the rollout of identity federations in Africa
 - Develop guidelines/best practices
- Onboard institutions within the region and without a national federation in order to support collaboration
- Join eduGAIN to
 - Showcase the global reach of Federated Identity Management (FIM)
 - Grow users, institutions, and policy makers & stakeholders' interest in Identity Federations - with the aim of boosting adoption of FIM in Africa
 - Support the individual NRENs' processes to join eduGAIN











eduID.africa: Governance & Roles



- Governance delegated to the three Regional Research & Education Networks (UbuntuNet Alliance (East and South Africa), WACREN (West and Central Africa) and ASREN (North Africa))
 - Mandated to plan, manage and run the federation
- Management, legal, operations and security teams also drawn from the three entities











eduID.africa: Eligibility



- All R&E related Services and Identity Providers willing to promote the adoption of Federated Identity Management (FIM) in Africa, with the purpose of promoting identity federations and eduGAIN in the continent
 - A continental workspace for users, services and institutions to get direct
 experience and gain familiarity with consuming and providing federated services
 and identities.
- Relevant services and identity providers who would benefit to join eduGAIN and FIM, who do not have a corresponding national identity federations
 - Encouraged to join edulD.africa











eduID.africa: Technical & Policy Status



Technical

- Federation Registry (Jagger) in place
 - https://registry.eduid.africa/
- Signed <u>metadata stream</u> available
 - https://registry.eduid.africa/signedmetadata/federation/eduid_africa/metadata.xml
- First IdPs registered from the 3 AC3 clusters (ASREN, UA, WACREN)
- Initial list of SPs identified (4 added to the federation)
- Other tools (SATOSA proxy, PyFF,...) to support technical operations
- Federation page/branding: Under review

Policy

- Federation Policy and MRPS Done
- eduGAIN Declaration signing Done
- Governance, legal and technical structure Done













eduID.africa: Security

- The three clusters coordinate to provide security support
 - General security mailing list will reach Security Teams in all of them
 - eduid@trustbroker.africa ⇒ eduid-operations@ren.africa ⇒ CSIRT queue
- Leverage RREN team/TBA for SIRTFI contacts where local teams don't have capacity.
 - Currently, RREN security teams ← ⇒ federation operation teams
 - To be eventually moved to dedicated security teams when capacity allows
- Promote adoption of SIRTFI and R&S entity-category among participating institutions and services











eduID.africa: Capacity Building & Engagement



- Workshops & Trainings
 - Regional trainings by the AC3 cluster members
 - FIM, FedOps, eduGAIN & tooling
- Direct Support
 - eduID.africa as a template (expertise, experiences, best practices & documentation)
 - Establishment of new identity federations
 - Facilitate admission to eduGAIN
- Catch-All
 - Engage researcher communities to showcase benefits and promote FIM to stakeholders.











edulD.africa: Next Steps



- Source and improve on the service catalogue
 - Provide value to the prospective members
- 'Recruit' more IdPs to the federation
- Works on bootstrapping new federations (eduID.africa as a template/experience?)
 - Nigeria, Kenya, Ethiopia
 - Somalia, Malawi, DRC, Tanzania,....
- Join eduGAIN
